

**Our shoe is a high heel boot from the early 1900's. Sold in a store called Emery, Bird, Thayer Co.**

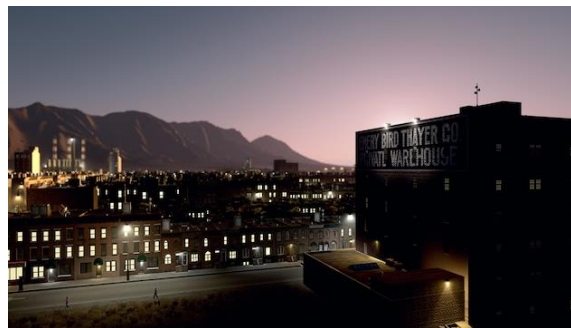


**The average wage for a factory worker during that time was \$1.37 a day. These boots were over two days' worth of work at \$2.75.**

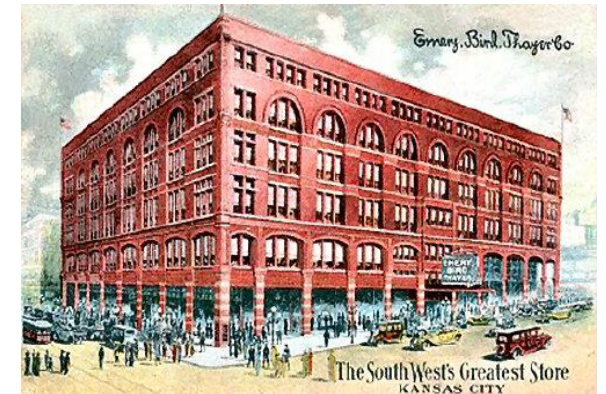

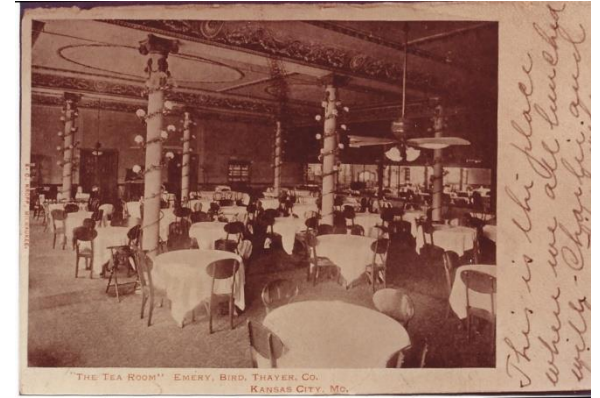


The company these shoes were sold in was located on Petticoat lane. An area in Kansas City where shopping was the name of the game.
